



STATEWIDE AFFORDABLE HOUSING AID (SAHA) BASIC SAFETY & LIVABILITY REPAIR PROGRAM

Traverse County is now accepting applications for housing assistance funded through the Statewide Affordable Housing Aid (SAHA) Program.

ELIGIBLE REPAIRS

Funding is available for basic health, safety, and livability improvements, including but not limited to:

- Roof patching or replacement
- Furnace / heating system repair
- Plumbing repairs (leaks or non-functioning systems)
- Electrical safety issues
- Window replacement
- Accessibility improvements (ramps, safety modifications)

NOT ELIGIBLE

- Major remodels
- Additions
- Cosmetic upgrades (kitchens, flooring, etc.)

ELIGIBILITY

- Must be an owner-occupied home
- Must be a Traverse County resident
- Income guidelines
- Proof of eligibility required
- Property may require inspection

PROGRAM DETAILS

- Payments made directly to contractors/vendors
- Detailed documentation required
- Projects must be completed within 1 year of award
- Awards may be limited and randomly selected if demand exceeds funding
- Awarding of funds may be contingent on pre or post inspection of the property
